



CALL FOR CIVIL SOCIETY INTERVENTIONS 'BRICS AND GLOBAL ECONOMY: CHALLENGES AND OPPORTUNITIES' DIALOGUE

The upcoming '**BRICS and Global Economy: Challenges and Opportunities**' dialogue is the first international event organized by the BRICS Finance Track Coordination under the Brazilian Presidency engaging Councils, Forums, and other civil society organizations from BRICS member countries.

The event will focus on economic and financial issues and should be featured into two sessions discussing:

- the integration of BRICS economies into the global economy;
- the strength of trade and investment among BRICS member countries as drivers of enhanced economic growth and a strategy for strengthening Emerging Markets and Developing Economies (EMDEs);
- the Finance Track priorities during Brazilian BRICS Presidency.

Therefore, BRICS Brazil Finance Track Civil Society Team is pleased to invite civil society organizations to virtually participate in the event, scheduled for April 16th 2025.

As participants, there will be two possibilities of engagement in the event:

- **As online streaming audience**, by attending both sessions of the live-streamed event on the Brazilian Ministry of Finance's YouTube channel, both English or Portuguese.
- **As interveners**, by submitting for consideration an up to three-minute intervention during '**Session II: BRICS and the Strengthening of Global South Economies**' addressed to keynote speakers' presentations. Organizations interested in making an intervention should submit their questions and proposals filling up the form available at the link below. **Ten proposed interventions should be selected**, and the organizations that proposed them will be invited to take the floor and deliver it live in the event. Interventions must be delivered in English, as it is the official language of the event.
